## **Soloy Announces Honeywell Engine Price Changes for 2014**

*Offering greater selection of LTS101 configurations and prices to better suit  
customers' AS350 requirements*

**Olympia, WA** – Soloy Aviation Solutions announced that operators of AS350B, BA and B2 helicopters may now select from a wide variety of engine configurations to better meet their operational or budgetary requirements.

For the AS350B and BA models, the LTS101-600A-3A will be available in 12 price configurations, varying from \$281,000 for the basic engine to \$415,000 for the zero time since overhaul version. The zero overhaul configuration includes new extended life air cooled GP turbine blades and all zero life limited/cycle limited components.

The LTS101-700D-2 used in the AS350B2 will also be available in 12 configurations, varying from \$297,000 for the basic engine to \$464,000 for a new production engine. The basic engine versions will have completed the 1800-hour inspection and a zero time since new extended life cooled GP turbine blades.



“The AS350 operators considering a Soloy conversion will find they have more options to choose from to fit their individual budgets,” commented Nick Parkinson, Soloy’s head of Helicopter Sales.

All engines will be delivered with a factory warranty of 1000 hours or two years. The accessories will have a 600 hour or one year warranty. The Honeywell engines will be in full compliance with current factory mandatory service bulletins.
